

## God Takes Care of His Children Ex. 11-16

\*The overall theme in the book of Exodus is that God takes care of His people.

- I. God had taken care of the children of Israel by leading them out of the land of Egypt.
  - A. Recap of the 10 plagues that were given to the land of Egypt.
    1. Water to Blood
    2. Frogs
    3. Lice
    4. Flies
    5. Disease of the Livestock
    6. Boils
    7. Hail
    8. Locusts
    9. Darkness
    10. Death of the Firstborn
  - B. When the Israelites left the land of Canaan, they had gold, silver and clothing with them.
    1. Ex. 11:2-3
    2. Ex. 12:35-36
  - C. They had been in the land for 430 years (Ex. 12:40-41).
  - D. God protected them by taking them through the wilderness instead of through the land of the Philistines (Ex. 13:17-18).
  
- II. God continued to take care of the children of Israel when they were out of the land of Egypt.
  - A. God gave them water when the water was bitter (Ex. 15:22-27).
    1. The Children of Israel complained about the water they had.
    2. God still provided for them –.
  - B. God gave them bread from heaven and quail when they were in the wilderness (Ex. 16).
  - C. Again, God took care of His children.
  
- III. We need to remember that God will take care of His children today.
  - A. Remember the basic theme of the first part of Exodus: God will take care of His people.
  - B. We can be His children today.
    1. I Pet. 2:9-10
    2. I Jn. 3:1-2
    3. John 1:12-13 – “But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, to those who believe in His name: { 13 } who were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God.”
    4. Rom. 8:16-17 – “The Spirit Himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God, { 17 } and if children, then heirs—heirs of God and joint heirs with Christ, if indeed we suffer with Him, that we may also be glorified together.”
